

STORYTELLING CHECKLIST

I understand the principles that guide my actions; I will PRINCIPLES afford the subject agency, respect, consent, and context. Did I get permission to be in their space? TAKE PHOTO Did I keep my hands off the camera? Did I build a rapport? Did I explicitly ask for a photo? Were they engaged in an action? Did I get permission to use the photo? Did the subject consent to the use of their image? SHARE PHOTO Is their expression in the photograph calm, confident, resolute? Does the photo offer enough background? Does the photo reinforce a stereotype? Is my caption dignifying or demeaning? Have I showed the image to the subject? Did I establish a relationship first? WRITE BLOG Did I get their permission to record their story? Did I inform them of my motive? Have I given the subject a voice in the writing? Is my tone informative or dramatic? Did I get permission to use the story? Do I know the subject consented to the use of their story? SHARE BLOG What do I focus on in the blog? What details have I omitted in my telling?

Are my descriptions dignifying or demeaning?

Have they read my final draft? Have I edited accordingly?
